Behavior Contract

It is an honor for our orchestra students to have the opportunity to travel and perform. It produces a unique learning experience beyond what we can provide in the classroom. In order to make these trips safe and provide the best environment for growth, we hold our students to a standard of behaviors that optimizes their learning potential. When students choose to deviate from the program's rules, there are consequences for their actions.

Failure to comply with the CSHS Orchestra travel guidelines, the orchestra handbook, the CSHS student handbook, and the contents of this contract will be handled by Mr. Hooper, the orchestra director. If the offense warrants termination of the trip, the student's parents will be responsible for all expenses including return transportation and/or expansion from the CSHS Orchestra. Offense that may result in trip termination may include:

- Any violation of the school alcohol and drug policies, as detailed in the student handbook
- Theft
- Violence, or horseplay
- Threats against another individual
- Violation of local law, or behavior that would cause the student to be removed from the hotel, restaurant, or any other visited establishment
- Promiscuity
- Switching rooms or entering a hotel room assigned to students of the opposite gender
- Failure to follow curfew
- Insubordination to any director or chaperone
- Failure to be on time for departures
- Profanity, or otherwise inappropriate language
- Non-compliance with school dress code policy

Prior to the trip, if a student should prove to be untrustworthy, or if they commit an offense that would put them in ISS/Venture before the trip date, that student will not be allowed to attend the trip and all money paid will be forfeit.
